Summer Programs for Students

Bears' Hockey: SJSH Bears' Summer Hockey School is accepting registrations from Grade 8, 9 and 10 students. This camp is open to both male and female students. You can pick up registrations packages at your school, the main office at SJSH, or on-line at www.npsc.ca. Cost is \$50 and includes over 30 hours of ice time, 70 hours of dry land training, and Health Education components. Students successfully completing the program will earn a Physical Education credit. Registration packages must be returned to SJSH by Friday, June 21.

Language Arts and Mathematics: Grade 7 and 8 students interested in registering for the Language Arts and Mathematics Summer Camp, are reminded to register by Friday, June 21.
